Apportioned Registration Payment Requirements

PURPOSE

This fact sheet provides information on Pennsylvania's Apportioned Registration Program requirement of guaranteed funds.

INFORMATION

The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is a member of the International Registration Plan. This plan allows for interstate operators to register their vehicles through their home state instead of having to deal directly with the many different states in which they operate. The home state involves the registrant and upon payment of the fees, promptly disburses the appropriate fees to other states.

PennDOT has a responsibility to collect money due to the other states, in the form of check or electronic transfers, and must ensure the proper funds are available in our bank account. Therefore, guaranteed funds are required in most situations. However, personal and company checks are acceptable under the following circumstances:

- ❖ The amount listed on the invoice is \$50 or less.
- ❖ The invoice is Pennsylvania fees only.
- ❖ If the renewal invoice is postmarked no later than April 10; however, credentials will be held for 20 days before being mailed to ensure the check is not returned by the bank. Therefore, if your renewal payment is postmarked April 10, your credentials will be mailed out in the first week of May.

NOTE: All other invoices require cashiers check or money order. If paying in person, you may pay with a check, money order or cash. Please do not send cash through the mail.
