INSTRUCTIONS

- ❖ Complete all information listed in Section A. **NOTE:** Change of address information need only be completed if address was changed since original registration plate was surrendered.
- ❖ Complete Section B by using the plate information listed on the applicant's copy of Form MV-141.
- ❖ Check the appropriate block in Section C. If a replacement plate is being issued by PennDOT, a copy of one of the following items must be attached to your application as proof of insurance:
 1. An insurance identification card issued by an insurance carrier or by a self-insured. PennDOT issues a certificate to self-insureds who are then authorized to produce an insurance ID card.
NOTE: Handprinted identification cards are unacceptable.
 2. The declaration page of an insurance policy or a copy thereof;
 3. A copy of a valid binder of insurance, which contains all the information required to appear on the ID card, excluding the policy number, and is signed by a licensed insurance agent or broker; or
 4. A copy of an application for insurance to the Pennsylvania Assigned Risk Plan, which contains all of the information required to appear on the ID card, excluding the policy number, and is signed by a licensed producer (insurance agent).
- ❖ When the replacement plate is being issued by an authorized decentralized messenger agent, the original copy of Form MV-120 must be attached.
- ❖ Only the following plates will be held by PennDOT after being surrendered and returned with Form MV-141:
